WHY THIS CERTIFICATE

This certificate equips participants with the knowledge, frameworks, and practical tools to lead responsible AI integration across their institutions.

Developed by the LUMS Learning Institute, this program bridges the gap between AI capability and institutional readiness.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The certificate is delivered across four progressive clusters, each building on the last.

01

Foundations of AI in Higher Education

Understanding generative AI capabilities, limitations, and implications for teaching and learning. Establishing shared vocabulary and critical perspectives.

02

Assessment Integrity & Redesign

Designing authentic, AI-resilient assessments. Rethinking evaluation strategies that maintain academic standards while embracing new tools.

03

Curriculum & Pedagogy Transformation

Integrating AI competencies into course design. Aligning learning outcomes with workforce demands and emerging disciplinary needs.

04

Institutional Strategy & Leadership

Developing governance frameworks, faculty development plans, and institutional AI policies. Leading sustainable organisational change.

CAPSTONE PROJECT

The capstone is a practical, institution-focused project that integrates learning from all four clusters. Participants develop a proposal addressing a real challenge within their own university context.

Selected projects may be considered for wider dissemination or publication, subject to participant consent and institutional review.
