Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who should apply?

Faculty members, academic leaders, deans, heads of department, academic managers, and higher education professionals seeking to integrate AI into teaching and institutional practice.

2. Is prior AI experience required?

No. The program is designed for beginners and professionals alike. No technical or programming background is required.

3. Is the program fully online?

Yes, this is a hybrid course, so you can attend most sessions online. However, to foster communities of practice, ensure smooth engagement throughout the program, and build rapport with peers and instructors, the in-person orientation (launch weekend) at LUMS followed by live online weekend sessions.

4. What technology is required?

Participants need a personal laptop, reliable internet access, and an active ChatGPT or Claude subscription.

5. Can participants join from outside Lahore?

Yes. Participants from across Pakistan and internationally are welcome. Only the orientation takes place on the LUMS campus.

6. What are the attendance requirements?

Participants are expected to attend the in-person orientation and actively participate in the live online sessions.
